INDICATIONS

PREPARATION AND USE

Preparing the Emesis Bag: Α.

- Open the packaging and remove the emesis bag. 1.
- 2. Ensure that the bag is fully expanded and that the closure mechanism is functioning properly.


B. Using the Emesis Bag:

- Position the bag near the patient's mouth to catch vomitus. 1.
- 2. Once the patient has finished vomiting, seal the bag using the closure mechanism.
- Dispose of the sealed emesis bag in accordance with the healthcare facility's biohazard disposal protocols. З.

C. Post-Use:

- Remove gloves and other protective equipment in line with hospital protocols. 1.
- Wash hands thoroughly after handling the emesis bag. 2.
